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# Licensing Requirements and Application Checklist LPN by Examination

### License Requirements for LPN by Examination

Below are the minimum requirements you must meet in order to be licensed in the state of Montana.

- 1. Application submitted at https://ebiz.mt.gov/ for an LPN license
- 2. Completion of an approved practical nursing education program that is authorized to prepare persons for licensure as practical nurses– ARM <u>24.159.422</u>
- 3. Passage of the NCLEX-PN ARM 24.159.422
- 4. Submission of fingerprints to the Montana Department of Justice for the purpose of a fingerprint-based background check -- <u>37-8-434</u>, MCA

#### Checklist of Required Documents to Submit for Application for LPN by Examination

The following documents and additional forms are required <u>in addition</u> to the basic application submitted at <u>https://ebiz.mt.gov/pol/</u>. Some documents may be submitted directly by the applicant as part of the application. Others, such as transcripts, may need to be sent to the board directly from the source.

- □ An official transcript sent directly from the education institution demonstrating degree and date conferred
- □ Registration with Pearson Vue for the NCLEX-PN at <u>https://www.nclex.com/</u>
- □ Fingerprint-Based Background Check Report from Montana Department of Justice
- □ Non-Criminal Notice of Applicants Rights form (this is automatically completed when you submit your application online)
- □ For internationally-educated applicants, credential review report (CGFNS CES or JSA Nursing Evaluation) from source

### Application Fee(s) for LPN by Examination

The following fee(s) must be submitted with your application. Online applicants can pay using a credit card or e-check.

□ \$100 application fee

You can apply for a license online at https://ebiz.mt.gov/POL/.

You must include a valid e-mail address with your application. E-mail is the department's primary form of communication.
