

Montana Prescription Drug Registry Information for Law Enforcement

The Montana Prescription Drug Registry (MPDR) utilizes PMP AWARxE Insight Reports for law enforcement requests. This is an on-line process for law enforcement to request MPDR information, law enforcement users will not have direct access to search MPDR information.

Please see the below information for a brief overview of the Insight Reports process which includes registering for an online account, requesting information, uploading required documentation, and receiving the requested information. Please see the <u>MPDR Law</u> <u>Enforcement User Guide</u> for more detailed instructions.

- <u>Registering for an MPDR Account</u> Create an online account at <u>MPDR PMP</u> <u>AWARxE [montana.pmpaware.net]</u> to access the Insight Report process and indicate your user role as Federal or State Law Enforcement or Licensing Board Investigator.
- <u>Requesting a Patient or Prescriber Report</u> You have access to Insight Reports, which allows you to request the patient or prescriber and dates online. You will be required to upload documentation (i.e., Subpoena or Board Investigator Form) to validate your request. Your request will remain in "Pending" status until the responding report is approved by an MPDR administrator.
 - Please note: For Patient Searches, please search using the first name, last name, and date of birth. If date of birth is not included, your search will be rejected. If other information (address, phone number etc.) is included, your search results may be inaccurate.
- <u>Receiving your Requested Report</u> Once your documentation and request has been approved, you will receive an email notification indicating that you can retrieve the results of your request from your online account. If your request is rejected, please contact the MPDR administrator for further information.
