- 1) Complete this form and return it.
- 2) Active Instructor licenses must complete the CE Attest Statement below.
- 3) Submit a check or money order for the appropriate fee, made payable to the Board of Barbers & Cosmetologists.
Do not send cash. Canadian and foreign residents pay in U.S. funds only.
- 4) Renewals with a U.S. Postal Service postmark after March 1st will be assessed a penalty fee by state law of 100% of the renewal fee. Failure to renew prior to March 2nd will result in your license lapsing.
- 5) If you fail to renew by the March 1st deadline, you may renew your license by completing the same procedure and paying the additional late fee equal to 100% of the licensing fee until April 15th.

The late fee is non-refundable and non-waivable.

CONTINUING EDUCATION ATTESTS STATEMENT: **Active Instructors only**, you are required to complete 30 hours of continuing education (CE) taken within the 24 months prior to March 1st.
