Inspection Checklist and Inspector Guidelines – Crematories (CRE)

- This is the same checklist used for initial licensure of new facilities and the annual inspections.
- "Crematory" for purposes of the parts of the facility that fall under the inspection criteria can be the whole building or the portion of the building that holds the cremation chamber and holder facility (37-19-301(14) MCA).
- If a facility does not meet compliance standards and is found to be "noncompliant" then inspector must notify the licensee of issue(s) of noncompliance and give them 10 days for the crematory operator-in-charge to submit written response per <u>ARM 24.147.403</u>.
