After listening to feedback and suggestions from licensees and stakeholders, the Montana Department of Labor & Industry and Board of Nursing are excited to announce a new, streamlined process for renewing your nursing license in 2018 and 2019.

Beginning this year, active status nursing licensees in the state of Montana will be randomly divided into two categories, designated as "Even Year" and "Odd Year" to renew your licenses moving forward. If you are an RN with an APRN license, you will have both licenses placed into the same renewal group.

YOU HAVE BEEN SELECTED FOR THE "ODD YEAR" LICENSING RENEWAL GROUP. YOUR LICENSE DOES NOT NEED TO BE RENEWED UNTIL 2019.

A copy of your updated license with the extended 2019 expiration date is included with this message.

You will receive notification <u>next year</u> to renew during the renewal period of Friday, November 1, <u>2019</u> through December 31, <u>2019</u>.
