APPROVED DRUG LIST FOR EMERGENCY KITS IN INSTITUTIONS

(Approved Board of Pharmacy Meeting April 10, 2010)

The Board of Pharmacy has determined the following drugs may be included in an emergency kit if a facility has a kit; however not all drugs need to be included:

Ciprofloxacin (Oral)
Dexamethasone Sodium Phosphate
Dextrose Injectable

Epinephrine Injectable
Esmolol
Fosphenytoin
Furosemide Injectable
Glucagon Injectable
Haloperidol Injectable
Hydrocortisone Sodium Succinate
Ketorolac Injectable
Lidocaine
Magnesium Sulfate
Methylprednisolone Injectable
Naloxone
Nitroglycerine Sublingual
Phenergan Rectal or Injectable
Potassium Chloride
Prochlorperazine Rectal or Injectable
Silver Sulfadiazine (Topical)
Sodium Bicarbonate
0.9% Sodium Chloride for Injection or Infusion
Sterile Water for Injection

Vasopressin
Vitamin K (Oral)

The following are Controlled Substances:

Hydrocodone with Acetaminophen (APAP)

(Each facility may select the dosage strength of Hydrocodone with Acetaminophen to use, but only one dosage strength may be kept in the emergency drug kit)

Diphenoxylate/Atropine (Oral)

Diazepam Injectable

Phenobarbital

Morphine 10mg/ml (single dose packaging, such as carpject or tubex)

The Board of Pharmacy expects that availability of these medications is limited to those institutions where appropriate training, education, and monitoring is available.

Legend IV administration devices are also approved.

ANY ADDITIONAL DRUGS MUST BE APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF PHARMACY PRIOR TO THEIR INCLUSION ON THIS LIST.
