Licensing Requirements and Application Checklist Radiologic Technologist

<u>License Requirements for a Radiologic Technologist License: [ARM 24.204.408, 37-14-302, MCA]</u>

Below are the minimum requirements you must meet in order to be licensed in the state of Montana.

- 1. An application for licensure shall be submitted to the board office with copies of the following documents:
 - a. three statements from persons attesting to the applicant's good moral character;
 - **b.** be at least 18 years of age;
 - c. not be addicted to intemperate use of alcohol or narcotic drugs;

And:

Evidence of certification by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (<u>ARRT</u>) in x-ray technology. This evidence shall consist of the applicant being listed in the current ARRT directory.

Or;

When the applicant is not listed in the current <u>ARRT</u> directory, the applicant shall submit to the board a certified copy issued by the ARRT of the original registration certificate that provides proof that a 24-month course of study in radiologic technology has been completed.

Checklist of Required Documents for a Radiologic Technologist License:

The following documents and additional forms are required <u>in addition</u> to the basic application. Some documents may be submitted directly by the applicant as part of the application. Others, such as transcripts, may need to be sent to the board directly from the source.

Application Fee(s) for a Radiologic Technologist:

The following fee(s) must be submitted with your application. Online applicants can pay using a credit card or e-check. If you submit a paper application you must submit a check. Do not mail cash.

□ \$100 – Application fee (includes temporary permit if requested to those who have completed the education but has not taken the examination, which expires 15 days after the date of the first opportunity for examination. Only one temporary permit will be issued.)

You can apply for a license online at https://ebiz.mt.gov/POL/ or download a paper application from the website. Online application is recommended.
