Minimum requirements:

- ☐ Proof of enrollment in the North American Registry of Midwives "Portfolio Evaluation Process" (PEP) or a school accredited by the Midwifery Education Accreditation Council (MEAC).
- ☐ Current certification in adult and infant cardiopulmonary resuscitation from the American Heart Association or the American Red Cross.
- ☐ Current certification in neonatal resuscitation from the American Academy of Pediatrics or the American Heart Association.

Submit these additional documents with your application (or request them directly from the issuing institutions):

- ☐ Supervision agreement (with a preceptor registered with the North American Registry of Midwives who is a direct-entry midwife, certified nurse midwife, physician, or naturopathic physician certified in naturopathic childbirth attendance).
- ☐ License verifications from other states.
- ☐ Explanations and final documents for any "yes" answers on personal history questions.
