Licensure Checklist for Naturopathic Physician

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Alternative Health Care Board
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Minimum requirements:

- ☐ Graduation from a program accredited by the Council on Naturopathic Medical Education (CNME).
- ☐ Passage of the North American Board of Naturopathic Examiners (NABNE) Naturopathic Physician Licensing Examination (NPLEX) in:
 - ☐ Biomedical Science (a Part I exam)
 - ☐ Core Clinical Science (a Part II exam)
 - ☐ Clinical Minor Surgery (a Part II exam)
 - ☐ Clinical Elective Pharmacology (a Part II exam)

Submit these additional documents with your application (or request them directly from the issuing institutions):

- ☐ License verifications from other states.
- ☐ Explanations and final documents for any "yes" answers on personal history questions.

For childbirth specialty:

- ☐ 100 hours of training in obstetrics.
- ☐ Care of 50 women in prenatal and postnatal periods under the direct supervision of a naturopathic, medical, or osteopathic physician with specialty training in obstetrics and/or natural childbirth.
- ☐ Attendance at 50 natural childbirths:
 - ☐ 25 of which as primary birth attendant
 - ☐ 3 of which in the last two years
 - ☐ 1 of which involving continuous care
- ☐ Passage of a specialty exam in obstetrics from the American College of Naturopathic Obstetrics (ACNO) or the Naturopathic Physician Licensing Examination's (NPLEX).
