(2) The following fees apply to landscape architects:
(a) and (b) remain the same.
(c) License renewal
(3) and (4) remain the same.

## IMP: 37-1-134, 37-1-141, 37-65-307, 37-66-309, MCA

<u>REASON</u>: The board determined it is reasonably necessary to amend this rule to comply with the provisions of 37-1-134, MCA, which requires the board to set fees that provide adequate funding for board operations. The board is also required to comply with 17-2-302 and 17-2-303, MCA, by not allowing the board's cash balance to exceed twice the annual appropriation amount. The board is reducing renewal fees to gradually decrease the board's cash balance and meet the statutory requirements while ensuring adequate revenue to support board activities through the next biennium. The board estimates the fee reductions will affect approximately 1,841 renewing licensees and result in a \$37,105 reduction in annual revenue.

4. Concerned persons may present their data, views, or arguments either orally or in writing at the hearing. Written data, views, or arguments may also be submitted to the Board of Architects and Landscape Architects, 301 South Park Avenue, P.O.
