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## Licensing Requirements and Application Checklist **Registered Process Server**

## **License Requirements for Registered Process Server**

Below are the minimum requirements you must meet in order to be licensed in the state of Montana.

- 1. 18 years of age or older [37-60-303 MCA]
- 2. Is a citizen of the United States or a legal, permanent resident of the United States [37-60-303 MCA]
- 3. Is a resident of the State of Montana for at least 1 year immediately preceding making application -[25-1102(3) MCA, ARM 24.182.516(2)]
- 4. Is of good moral character [37-60-303 MCA]
- 5. Has not been convicted in any jurisdiction of any felony and not convicted of any crime involving moral turpitude or illegal use or possession of a dangerous weapon, for which a full pardon or similar relief has not been granted; [25-1-1102(2) MCA, 37-60-303 MCA]
- 6. Has not been judicially declared incompetent by reason of any mental disease or disorder or if so declared, has been fully restored - [37-60-303 MCA]
- 7. Is not suffering from habitual drunkenness or from narcotics addiction or dependence [37-60-303 MCA1
- 8. Has passed Department-approved background check through Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Montana Department of Justice [37-60-303(6) MCA, ARM 24.182.501]
- 9. Has passed the Department-approved examination based on the process server handbook [37-60-303(4) MCA, ARM 24.182.505, ARM 24.182.516]
- 10. Shall maintain a surety bond in the amount of \$10,000 for an individual or \$100,000 for a firm. A levying officer may not levy on a judgment that exceeds the value of the bond. [25-1-1111 MCA, ARM 24.182.405]

## Checklist of Required Documents to Submit for Application for Registered Process Server

The following documents and additional forms are required in addition to the basic application. Some documents may be submitted directly by the applicant as part of the application. Others, such as transcripts, may need to be sent to the Department directly from the source.
